## History

- Established in 2010 by UG Academic Affairs and Financial Aid to review financial aid appeals from students with academic issues.
- Committee formed quickly due to great benefit to student of timely, comprehensive and thoughtful solutions versus the usual "hand-off" between administrative offices
- Representatives from other units joined on a voluntary basis as breadth of committee work grew in order to better meet student needs
- Focus shifted in time from only individual student cases to include university retention efforts, student degree completion and making proactive changes to administrative processes to decrease student issues and concerns

The SSC aims to improve retention and graduation rates as well as create efficient student solutions through the integration of office processes and communication between partnering offices.

- Support institutional academic goals for retention and the six year graduation rate
- Explore student trends from year to year
