

Report of the Undergraduate Studies Committee 5.5.2017

In the 4.11.17 UGSC meeting the following items were presented and are forwarded to the University Faculty Council for approval:

New Co-Terminal Degree – B.S. in Materials Science and Engineering and Master of Material Science and Engineering: This co-terminal program presented by Sudhakar Nair and Sumanta Acharya was approved unanimously. Termination of Co-Terminal Degree Programs in ECE: The proposal by the ECE Department to eliminate the B.S. Electrical Engineering/Master of Electrical and Computer Engineering and the B.S. Computer Engineering/Master of Electrical and Computer Engineering co-terminal degrees was approved with some dissent. It was requested that the minutes acknowledge that UGSC has no jurisdiction on the elimination of degrees according to Appendix P of the faculty handbook.

In the 4.25.17 UGSC meeting the following items were presented and are forwarded to the University Faculty Council for approval:

New Co-Terminal Degree – B.S. in Biomedical Engineering and M.S. in Biology for Health Professions: This co-terminal program presented by Katherine Spink was approved unanimously.
