Pursuant to input from faculty, industry associates, and active students working in industry, INTM's curriculum committee has recommended the following changes to specializations offered within the Bachelor of Industrial Technology and Management (BINTM) program. These changes serve to 1) better identify the content and focus of INTM specializations, and 2) enhance the program's ability to market the program and attract new students to IIT.

Specialization changes to take effect spring 2019 are as follows:

• Realign existing electives in the INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES (IF) specialization into two specializations, titled as follows:

FACILITIES MANAGEMENT (FM) (a new specialization) INTM 314 Maintenance Technology and Management **INTM 411 Functional Facilities Management INTM 416 Integrated Facilities Management** INTM 423 Sustainable Facilities Management

CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGY (CT) (replaces/new title for IF specialization) INTM 407 Construction Technology INTM 413 Contract Administration for Construction Projects INTM 415 Advanced Project Management **INTM 417 Construction Estimating**

Eliminate the TELECOMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (TT) specialization Due to extremely low interest in this specialization
