Over the Fall semester of 2019, the CAC conducted a review of all C-courses with the designations AS, MILS, and NS in order to ensure that they were in compliance with the UGSC-established criteria for such courses. The UGSC mandated that a committee be established to do this, made up of the CAC director (Pulliam), a faculty member from ROTC (Christopher Adams of NROTC) and a faculty member from outside of ROTC (John Twombly of SSB).
