Initial review was satisfied on most criteria (great to acceptable, with minor issues – we will need to deal with these too!) **but poor in one area** (*"Met With Concerns"*): 4.B - Core Component. Three major areas identified:

- 1. Core curriculum major issue, virtually no assessment done on an issue we were already in delinquency on.
- 2. Program assessments; here the issue that compliance is dropping: AY17 75% of programs submitted reports; AY18 65% AY19 56%. We will need to get to 100%
- 3. Co-curricular assessment

#### IIT's response:

the University plans to reconstitute our Core Curriculum Committee (CCAC) with the express purpose of revisiting both our learning goals and the artifacts whereby we measure and assess these goals.

We need to get the CCAC up and running ASAP

- The core is a key responsibility of UGSC

- Review assessment plans, schedule, and tools. immediately by mid fall 2021
- Implement assessment. Begin F21, in earnest S22 and AY23
- Develop interim report by May 2023
- Continue action on an ongoing basis
- Monitor continuous improvement what do we DO with assessment results? "Closing the loop" and "continuous improvement" are crucial to HLC

## Deliverables

#### Interim Report(s) Required

Due Date 6/30/2023

An **interim report** is required on assessment of the core curriculum. This report is related to Core Component 4B and should include:

- A summary statement describing the institutional progress on core curriculum assessment since July 1, 2021, decisions made about the core curriculum as a result of assessment processes, plans for the future development of the core curriculum and its assessment, and any special circumstances affecting development and implementation of core curriculum assessment
- A description of the governance structure for core curriculum assessment, including responsibilities of key personnel
- A statement of the core curriculum learning outcomes
- A listing of the core curriculum requirements
- A mapping of the learning outcomes to the core curriculum requirements
- A description of the core curriculum assessment strategies, including both <u>direct</u> and <u>indirect</u> measures
- Copies of the core curriculum assessment tools used or to be used
- A schedule of core curriculum assessment activities executed or planned from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2026 demonstrating coverage of <u>all</u> core curriculum learning outcomes
- **Minutes** of core curriculum assessment committee or other relevant meetings at which assessment of the core curriculum is discussed from July 1, 2021 to May 31, 2023
- Reports of core curriculum assessment results from July 1, 2021 to May 31, 2023
- A <u>description of faculty involvement</u> in the development and implementation of core curriculum assessment
- A description of **faculty and staff professional development activities** executed or planned related to core curriculum assessment

#### Focused Visit(s)

#### Due Date 6/30/2025

A **focused visit** is required on core curriculum, program, and co-curricular assessment. This visit is related to Core Component 4B and should include:

• Review of all aspects of the institution's assessment program, including those elements required in the interim report on core curriculum assessment and similar elements for program and co-curricular assessment

NB - none if this is final. This is recommendation of peer review; action is needed by HLC's IAC (institutional action committee) and also potentially their Board of Trustees, this fall. We have been told this is "~80% likely the result, but may change around the edges".

Then – this pushes up against our regular full accreditation cycle, which occurs 2026
