Illinois Tech's Road to IAI Full Participation



Current Approval List

Communication 3 courses required -> C1901R, COM 421 Approved

Humanities and Fine Arts 3 Courses required -> H9900, HUM 204 Approved

Mathematics 1 to 2 courses -> 5 Math courses were approved

Physical Sciences and Life Sciences 2 courses required -> 1 Physical Science w/ Lab was approved

Social and Behavioral Sciences 3 courses total, from at least 2 different disciplines -> 5 social science courses in 3 different subjects were approved

Remaining IAI course categories submitted



1. 2 Communications Courses
 - a. C1900 - COM 101
 - b. C2900 - COM 428
2. 1 Fine Arts / 1 Humanities Course
 - a. F2900- AAH 201
 - b. H9900- HUM 206
3. 1 Life Sciences Course
 - a. L1900- BIOL 105

All five courses, along with P9900-PHYS 200 have been submitted before the Spring deadline of March 1st, 2022

- We will know the final decision on submitted course syllabi by May 2022

Maintaining Full Participation

IAI requires a course syllabus review every five years.

- IIT will start the review process in Fall 2025
- This will include submitting an updated syllabus for the approved course

Any changes to the course (ex. course description, syllabus, topics covered) will also need to be submitted to IAI

- This is to keep our syllabus information up to date in the IAI iManage system
