## Minor Change to the Coursera Degree Programs in Information Technology

As an information item: At the request of the university administration, the Department of Information Technology and Management proposes changing the course path for admission to each of the Information Technology Coursera degree programs to three one credit hour courses as discussed below.

- 1. **Bachelor of Information Technology:** Replace ITM 301 Introduction to Contemporary Operating Systems and Hardware I in the Coursera degree program with three one credit hour courses. These courses will be the existing ITM 301 course split into three one credit hour courses. These courses will be identical in content to ITM 301 but will have three examinations and award credit as three one hour courses, to be named and numbered as presented below.
  - a. ITM 701 Introduction to Contemporary Operating Systems and Hardware 1A
  - b. ITM 702 Introduction to Contemporary Operating Systems and Hardware 1B
  - c. ITM 703 Introduction to Contemporary Operating Systems and Hardware 1C
- 2. Master of Information Technology: Replace ITMO 503 Hardware and Operating System Foundations in the Coursera degree program with three one credit hour courses. These courses will be the existing ITMO 503 course split into three one credit hour courses. These courses will be identical in content to ITMO 503 but will have three examinations and award credit as three one hour courses, to be named and numbered as presented below.
  - a. ITM 705 Hardware and Operating System Foundations I
  - b. ITM 706 Hardware and Operating System Foundations II
  - c. ITM 707 Hardware and Operating System Foundations III
- 3. These changes were approved by the ITM Curriculum Committee and the Department of Information Technology and Management faculty on Thursday, April 4 and are forwarded to the Undergraduate Studies Committee as an information item.
