Next steps...maintaining IAI Participation



1. Continued collaboration with faculty (UGSC) and academic units regarding review of courses
 - a. Review occurs every five years starting in Fall 2025
 - i. ECON 151, PS 230, PS 200, PS232, PSYCH 221, MATH 122, MATH 152, MATH 251, MATH 152, MATH 225, COM 421, HUM 204
2. Panel Membership
 - a. Openings available in Humanities/Fine Arts, Life Sciences, Mathematics GECC Panels
3. Alignment with Core Curriculum
 - a. The current carve-outs outlined means that students will need to take an additional 12-15 credits (a full semester) to meet Illinois Tech core-curriculum requirements
 - b. This is not aligned with IAI as fully-participating institutions must accept a completed GECC package and cannot require students to take additional general education courses beyond the package



Current Carve-Outs

- Additional 300 Level HUM course (3 CR)
- Additional 300 Level Social Science course (3 CR)
- Additional Math course (equivalent of MATH 119 or higher) (3-5 CR)
- Additional Natural Science course (in a second field) (3-4 CR)
- ITP course (2 CR)
- IPRO (6 CR)
- CS (2 CR)

These *carve outs* will require a student to complete an equivalent of at least one additional semester (not counting ITP & IPRO) even after successfully transferring with a full GECC Package.

*IPRO and CS can be potential carve-outs as it can meet the institutional-mission requirements
