Credential Evaluation & Transcript Compliance





Objective

- Establish a consistent standard evaluation process for academic transcripts, including int'l credential evaluation, GPA recalculation to a U.S. standard 4.0 scale, and the securing of official transcript(s) with verified English translation as applicable for all enrolled students.
- Why?
 - Ensures institution recognition and accreditation
 - Enhances document authenticity and verification
 - Increased transparency in admission requirements for applicants
 - Native language and English translation requirements
 - Consistent policy application
 - Three-year degrees, equivalency statements, comparability, retakes/failed courses

 - "TAICEP"
 - A credential evaluation professional is an individual who is involved with the assessment and/or recognition of
 international educational credentials. The evaluations provided by credential evaluation professionals assist
 educational institutions, regulatory bodies, assessment agencies, employers, government authorities and others to
 appropriately recognize international education.
 - Responsibilities include:
 - Promote fair, credible, standardized methods for evaluation
 - Collaborate to encourage consistency and to facilitate the portability of evaluations at the regional, national and global levels
 - Ascribe to the Statement of Ethics
 - Encourage equitable access to services and transparency of the process
- American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers
 - "AACRAO" Edge
 - EDGE provides valuable information that supports institutional decision-making in international recruitment, admissions, academic placement and the evaluation of international transfer credit.
 - The information in EDGE is extensively researched by professional evaluators using primary sources from each country. Grading scale translations and placement recommendations are vetted by the International Education Standards Council (IESC) and represent the consensus expert opinion in the U.S.


Processing Volume
