The manuscript will include an Introduction section briefing background and proposing a research question; a Literature Review section on theory and empiricism related to the research question; a Study Area section describing socioeconomic and environmental characteristics related to your research question; a Data and Methods section detailing data and study methods; a Results and Discussion section reports results and findings of data analyses and related discussions; a Conclusions and Policy Implications section summarizes findings to make conclusions on your research question and provides relevant policy implications. This assignment focuses on solving problems and the communication of results and conclusions.
