Can you please add me to the agenda for Tuesday? I'd like to discuss the (N) attribute. I know this has been discussed in years past, but nothing has come of it, and every year we get emails with complaints from advisors and students.

[The current policy states:](#)

Natural Science or Engineering: 10-11 credit hours. This component may be satisfied by courses in engineering, biology, chemistry, physics, or courses in architecture, food safety and technology, and psychology marked with an **(N)**.

Currently, the policy reads that all courses in engineering, biology, chemistry, physics will fulfill the requirement, but only BIOL 105 and PHYS 200 have the (N) attribute. As for architecture, food safety and technology, and psychology, only ARCH 230, ARCH 334, ARCH 335, FDSN 201, FDSN 300, PSYC 204, PSYC 411 and PSYC 414 have the (N) attribute.

I think for consistency's sake, any applicable BIOL, CHEM and PHYS courses should also have the (N) attribute, and this should be discussed in UGSC.
