

## Draft Resolution on the Reapportionment of the UGSC

Appendix B, Article 5.D defines the charge and membership of the Undergraduate Studies Committee of the UFC. Prior to the University restructure, UGSC membership included 19 members. According to Article 5.D.2 "each academic unit (AU) offering one or more continuing undergraduate degree programs shall annually elect a voting member to the UGSC". Additional voting members include ROTC and SGA representatives (Article 5.D.3).

The new University structure identifies the schools as the AU, decreasing UGSC membership from 19 to 7.

This resolution is an interim measure to reestablish a functioning UGSC for AY26-27 while the handbook is amended to reflect the new University structure.

UGSC membership will be composed of 12 voting members representing academic units offering one or more continuing undergraduate degree programs with each school represented by 2 voting members and the remaining members apportioned by a factor that includes both the number of programs and the number of students. ROTC and SGA will also be additional voting members. The allocation is as follows:

| School                                   | Voting Members |

| Engineering, Applied Science, and Health | 4              |
| Law*                                     | 0              |
